Exclusive Plant Tour at Volkswagen Poznań

On 26th of November 1993, the Volkswagen Group founded Volkswagen Poznań in Poland. Today, Volkswagen Poznań consists of four modern production plants that manufacture commercial vehicles and components.

The history of the Antoninek plant in Poznań began over 30 years ago with an initial workforce of 48 employees who assembled the fourth generation of the Transporter using the semi-knocked-down (SKD) process. Following extensive plant expansion between 2001 and 2003, production of the third generation Volkswagen Caddy began at the Antoninek plant alongside the Volkswagen Transporter.

Since November 2003, more than 2.8 million units of the 3rd, 4th and 5th generation Volkswagen Caddy have rolled off the production line of the Poznań plant, which produces these vehicles exclusively for the world.

At the 19th Congress organised by Automotive Lean Production, you will gain an insight into the development of the fifth generation of the Volkswagen Caddy. You will learn how employees are improving their skills in troubleshooting robot failures with the help of interactive tools. You will discover a modern method of 3D scanning car bodies that is revolutionising fault detection in paintwork.

We will also show you how we protect the environment and save costs at the same time thanks to heat recovery technology. We will present these and many other optimisation solutions to congress participants during an exclusive factory tour in Antoninek near Poznań, where a maximum of 750 modern Volkswagen commercial vehicles roll off the production line every day.
